G2: RASC Halifax Centre Objectives

(Adopted: December 8, 2016)

Background

Prior to 2016, the Objectives were included in the Bylaw #1. At the recommendation of the Registry of Joint Stock Companies, they were removed from the bylaws and are considered a separate document from the bylaw for ease of amendments.

On December 8, 2016, the objectives were adopted by Special Resolution at the Annual General Meeting.

Objectives

- (1) to stimulate interest and to promote and increase knowledge in astronomy and related sciences,
- (2) to work in conjunction with the Society, other Centres of the Society, and other organizations to further the progress of astronomy in Canada,
- (3) to acquire and maintain equipment, libraries, astronomical observatory and other property necessary for the pursuit of its objectives,
- (4) to publish through print and electronic media material containing information on the progress of astronomy and the work of the Society and the Centre,
- (5) to receive and administer gifts, donations and bequests from members of the Centre and others, and
- (6) to make contributions and render assistance to individuals, groups and institutions engaged in the study and advancement of astronomy.
