## Background

Prior to 2016, the Objectives were included in the Bylaw #1. At the recommendation of the Registry of Joint Stock Companies, they were removed from the bylaws and are considered a separate document from the bylaw for ease of amendments.

On December 8, 2016, the objectives were adopted by Special Resolution at the Annual General Meeting.

## Objectives

(1) to stimulate interest and to promote and increase knowledge in astronomy and related sciences,

(2) to work in conjunction with the Society, other Centres of the Society, and other organizations to further the progress of astronomy in Canada,

(3) to acquire and maintain equipment, libraries, astronomical observatory and other property necessary for the pursuit of it objectives,

(4) to publish through print and electronic media material containing information on the progress of astronomy and the work of the Society and the Centre,

(5) to receive and administer gifts, donations and bequests from members of the Centre and others, and

(6) to make contributions and render assistance to individuals, groups and institutions engaged in the study and advancement of astronomy.
