Education & Public Outreach	Outreach is an enjoyable and rewarding volunteer activity for RASC Halifax Centre members. Seeing the joy and wonder on a person's face the first time they see craters on the Moon or the rings of Saturn is a priceless experience. Target audiences include people of all ages attending an astronomy-themed day at the Discovery Centre or a sidewalk astronomy event, primary and secondary school classes, and youth groups such as the Young Naturalists Club. Although most outreach opportunities involve using binoculars or a telescope, there can also be requests for an astronomy-related slide presentation at a local library or via Zoom. Outreach is usually conducted in the Halifax area but may involve travel to a location within a couple hours drive from Halifax.
